Question (some paraphrased/summarized)	Answer
Would participation in Water Planning Council Advisory Council meetings be eligible in that option participation add-on?	Yes
Could this be used for land acquisition?	Noting the award limit, if there's an opportunity that fits within the funding amounts and it fits with the program goals, yes.
Is community specifically spacial? could it be black farmers , queer stewards ect.	A community does not have to be specifically spatial (as in, not necessarily contiguous), but the CBO and community inclusion piece would still need to be present in the project.

If we are part of state boards would those count as meetings? CEEJAC, Food policy council ect. So we could be in the board and not an outside entity and still count?	Yes. If you are on a state board or subcommittee (or choose to join one), those count as meetings for the optional participation add-on.
Can we reapply next year if we win grant this year. If its like to continue something.	We don't yet know if there will be another round next year, we can only speak to this year. But there is no restriction on re-applying if you have previously been awarded a grant.
Is Park Watershed eligible? 501c3 organization	Yes, this would be an eligible organization, as long as the project aligns with the grant program goals / increases capacity for climate-vulnerable communities for mitigation/adaptation, etc.
